Challenges

- Most properties leased not owned
- Often part of a larger facility
- Implementation

RECYCLING

Challenges

- Ability to off-load onboard recyclables
 - Availability
 - Consistency of procedures
 - Onboard
 - Different ground handlers
- Metrics, tracking, and economics

- Improvements in local markets
- Potential to work within airport programs
 - Promotion of recycling in common-use areas
 - Other materials on case-by-case basis





WATER CONSERVATION

Challenges

- Similar to energy efficiency
 - Leased not owned
 - Part of larger facility
 - Implementation
- Not a lot of use (no driver/ROI)
- Less glycol = more water

- Installations as part of remodeling
- Improved capture/reuse options for wash water





COMMUNITY OUTREACH

Challenges

- Great geographical distribution
- Magnitude of requests
- Limited discretionary spending

- Great geographical distribution
- Unique opportunity as service industry
- Employee volunteerism
 - Interest
 - Schedule flexibility
