NEW PARTNERSHIPS

This September marked the kickoff of OMD’s expanded partnership with the City Colleges of Chicago (CCC) and the City of Chicago.

Through its expanded partnership with the City Colleges of Chicago, OMD will support thousands of low-income community college students over the next five years.

In October, we welcomed a cohort of 69 incredible OMD Scholars from Kennedy-King College (KKC) as part of this expansion. These scholars are resilient, visionary, and have big plans for their futures.

In September 2014, OMD welcomed its first cohort of 41 OMD Scholars from Harper College. Harper College is providing staff support, weekly individual tutoring, space and materials for OMD programming, and help with recruiting volunteers and partners to support the program.
